The Outdoor Leader Skills course teaches Scoutmasters/Asst Scoutmasters the outdoor skills they need in order to help a Scout reach the rank of First Class Scout. It is a required course for adult leaders registered as Scoutmasters/Asst Scoutmasters in order for them to earn the trained patch in their registered position. Attendance at this course is recommended for all Scout Leaders, not only those who plan to attend a Wood Badge course, but also for those who work with their unit's youth in their outdoors program. Only those registered as Scoutmasters/Asst Scoutmasters may earn the trained patch by attending.
